Focus

Over the next half term, we will be developing children's 'Literacy', by choosing a different book each week as our focus. We kick off with 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt'.

Thursday 6th March is World Book Day, and we would like to celebrate this at Acorns. If your child would like to dress as a book character, or wear their pyjamas, or simply bring in their favourite book for the day, staff will be joining in the dress code!!

Remember that we visit the library each Wednesday. Please return your child's book, so that they are able, to choose a new one to bring home. If your child has not already joined the library, we have forms available, please ask. The importance of sharing stories with your child cannot be emphasised enough!

Makaton – I recently attended a level 2 Makaton session, which I am very passionate about. For those who do not know, Makaton is a form of sign language, which is used alongside speech. From Monday I will begin to teach some basic words to the children, which we will use in everyday situations going forward. Each week we will let you know via our Facebook posts which signs we have learned. It would be great if this could be used at home, especially for those children who have difficulties communicating.

This is word that usually sets any education setting into total panic!!!! For some reason I have volunteered Acorns to undergo a mini-inspection for Ofsted training purposes. I am sure most of you will be fully aware of the bad press Ofsted have received in recent years, something they are working hard to rectify with the changes to their working practice from September.

An inspector will be visiting us on Wednesday 26th February, for a short 2-3 hours, during which they will take feedback from the staff about the inspection process. We will not receive any judgement ourselves, unless our safeguarding procedures cause any concern. So, only well-behaved children that day please!!

Holiday Club

Whilst we realise that some parents rely on our provision during the holidays, we cannot sustain this without the numbers. Over half term we tried to run all 3 days, at a significant loss on Tuesday. As a result, we are having to rethink how holiday club is managed. We encourage all families to book early so that we have an indication of need. Over the Easter holidays we will initially offer all sessions as usual, however, we will assess the situation on 17th March. A decision will then be made as to the validity of opening all days. Booking forms are available now, so please book in good time.
